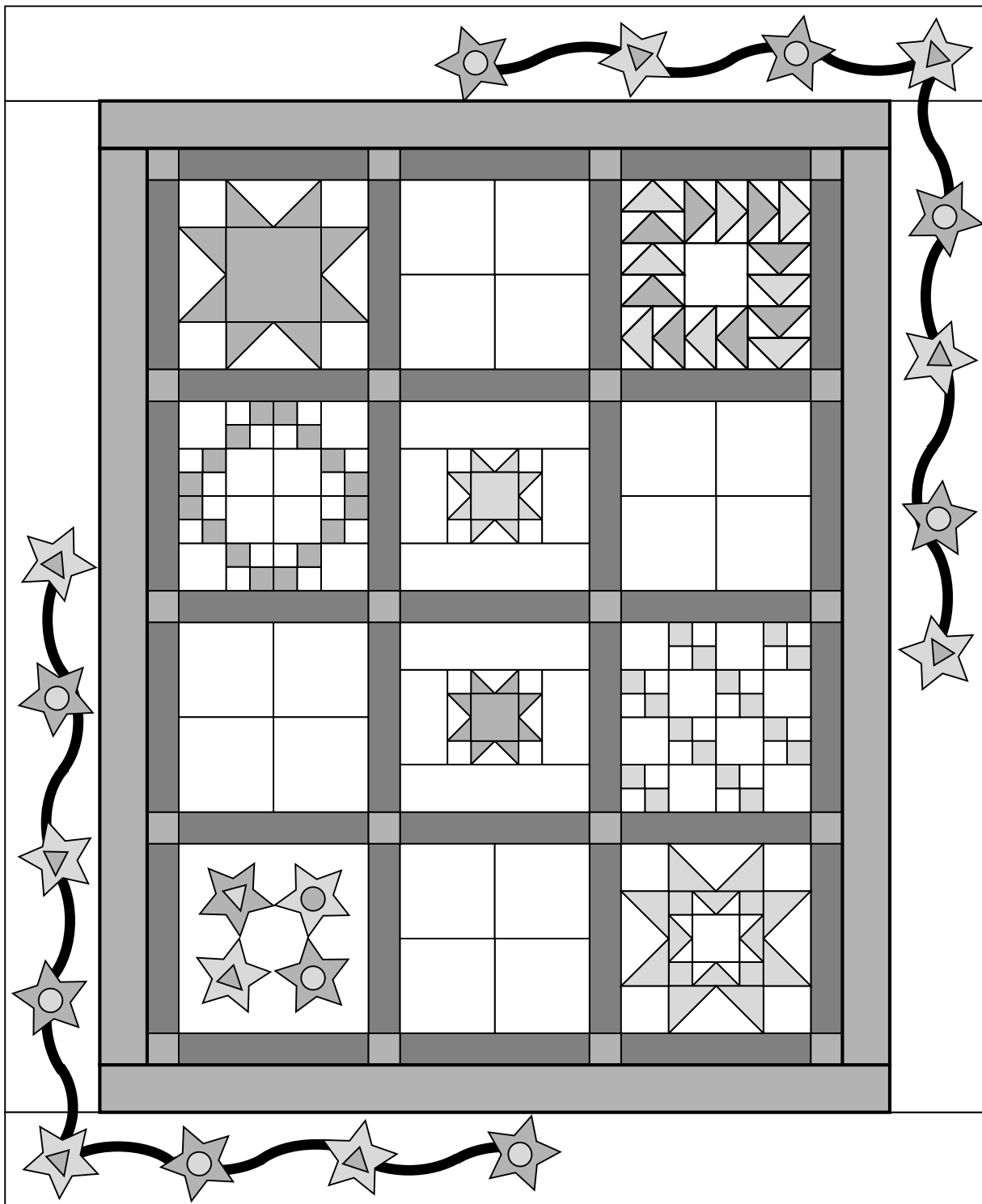

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Free Hand Samper V2

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| V2 Free Hand Sampler Quilt 63 x 77 inches Yardage Amounts |
| Background Fabric – 3-1/4 yards Light Fabric Includes Outer Border |
| Fabric A - 1-1/2 yards Red Fabric Includes Appliquéd Stars, Cornerstones and Inner Border |
| Fabric B - 1 yard Blue Fabric Includes Appliquéd Stars |
| Fabric C - 1 yard Purple Fabric Includes Sashing and Appliquéd Stems |
| Backing Fabric - 5 yards of 40 inch wide fabric, Vertical Seam OR 2-1/2 yards 108 inch wide backing fabric |
| Batting - 2-1/2 yards, 90 inch wide batting |
| Binding Fabric - 3/4 yard Your choice of fabric. |

Other items needed for piecing the quilt top -

- **Steam A Seam 2** or a similar paper backed, fusible web for fusible appliqué
- Note: for my sample of this quilt, I used the **Lite Steam A Seam**. It came in a package of 5 - 9 x 12 inch sheets. I used 2 packages for my sample. I purchased this product at my local JoAnn Fabrics store.
- Piecing template plastic, or similar, for appliqué pieces.

Other items need for quilting -

- Marking pens of choice. I prefer the Crayola Washable Markers. Note - to remove the marker, the quilt **MUST** be washed in warm water, with detergent, in a washing machine.
- Circle "templates" or household items that are circular that measure 5-1/2 to 6 inches in diameter. (In the Free Hand Sampler V2 video I used the top of a DVD holder for this.) You can make your own circle templates from the piecing template plastic using the patterns that are included in the piecing instructions.
- Straight edge rotary cutting rulers for marking registration lines. This will all be explained in the video class.
