

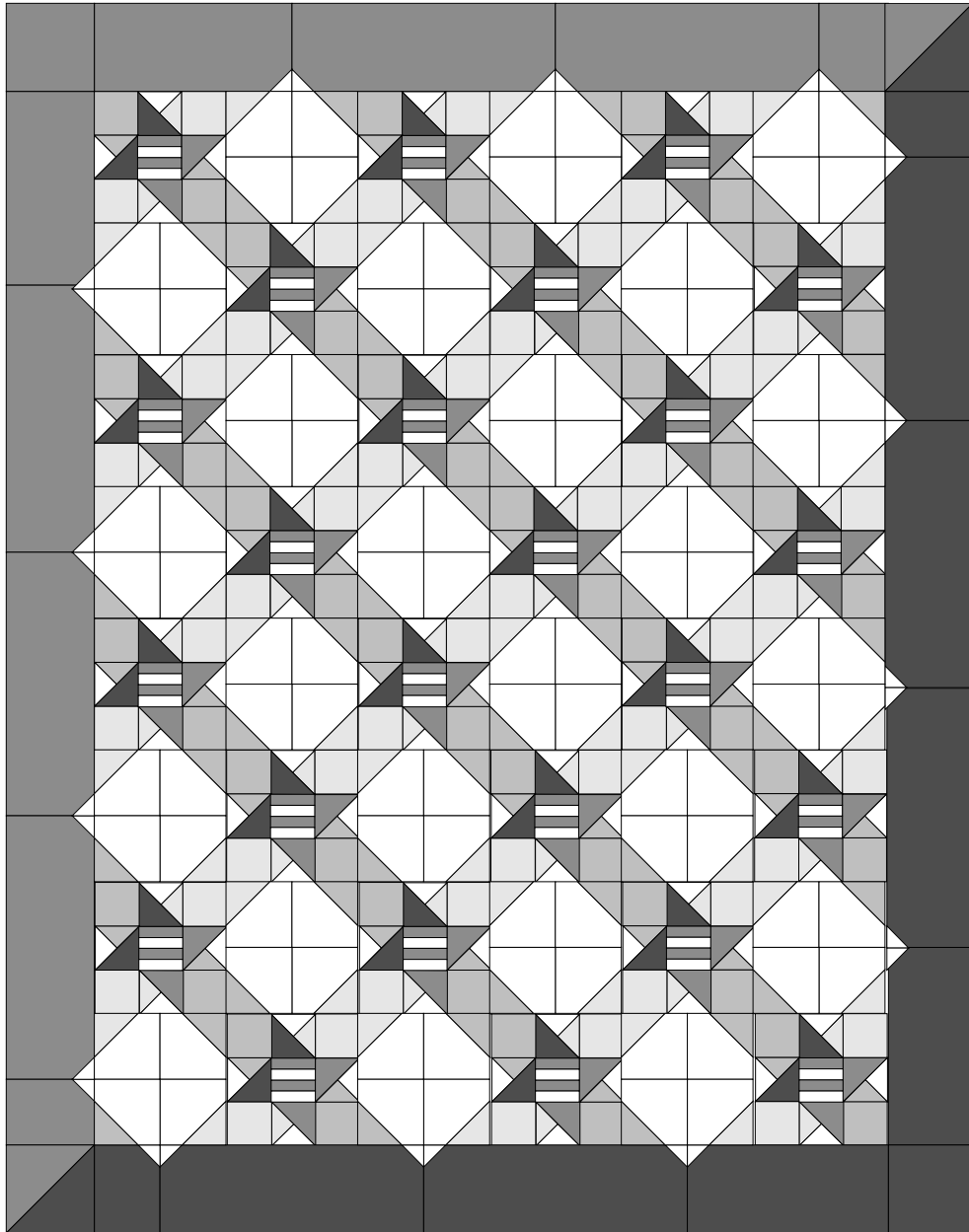

## Woven Stars Quilt Yardage Amounts

Note: Amounts are generous

Note - For this quilt, the QUILTING is the star!! Choose a **Background fabric** that is a solid or "reads" like a solid fabric. **We want the quilting to show!**

<b>Background Fabric (White)</b> All versions	3/4 yards	3 yards
<b>Red Fabric</b> Star Points Patriotic Star	Fat Quarter or 1/4 yard	3/4 yards
<b>Blue Fabric</b> Star Points Patriotic Star	Fat Quarter or 1/4 yard	3/4 yards
<b>Star Center</b> Patriotic Star & "Plain" Star	Fat Quarter or 1/4 yard	1/2 yard
<b>Star Points</b> "Plain" Star	Fat Quarter or 1/4 yard	1 yard
<b>Star Center - Pieced</b>	1/8 yard or Scraps from red and white fabrics	1/4 yard or Scraps from red and white fabrics
<b>Fabric #1 (Yellow #1)</b> All versions	1/2 yard	1-1/2 yards
<b>Fabric #2 (Yellow #2)</b> All versions	1/2 yard	1-1/2 yards
<b>Border Fabric #1 (Red)</b>	1/2 yard	3/4 yard
<b>Border Fabric #2 (Blue)</b>	1/2 yard	3/4 yard
<b>Backing Fabric</b> Vertical Seam	1-1/2 yards (no seam)	5-1/4 yards (vertical seam)
<b>Binding</b>	1/2 yard	3/4 yard

Other items you will need for the quilting -

**Marking pens of choice.** I prefer the Fine Point Crayola Washable Markers or any other maker you prefer.

Note - to remove the Crayola Washable Marker, the quilt **MUST** be washed in warm water, with detergent, in a washing machine.

**Plastic Piecing Template Material** - can be found in most fabric / quilt stores. This will be cut to a specific size before we begin quilting.

**Straight edge rotary cutting rulers** for marking registration lines.

**Safety Pins** - for pin basting areas on the quilt top during quilting.

If you are making a quilt for the American Hero Quilts Challenge, here are some things the American Hero Quilts want you to consider. These are taken from the American Hero Quilts website at [www.americanheroquilts.com](http://www.americanheroquilts.com)

- Quilts should be made from 100% good quality cotton.
- Quilts should be approximately 63×87 inches. We find that many of the soldiers need the extra length and width to keep warm.
- Colors should be red, white and blue—standard patriotic colors.
- Backs should be 100% cotton
- Please don't use beige or white fabrics on the back. Many of our injured soldiers have open wounds which can cause stains.
- Certain fabrics should not be used because they may interfere with the healing process of wounds. These fabrics include flannel, corduroy, fleece, and fabrics with sparkles.
- Fabrics should be washed and ironed before assembling the quilt.
- These standards may seem overly demanding and difficult, but we cannot emphasize enough the importance of providing quality quilts to our wounded heroes.
- Also note - Gold stars represent a fallen soldier. If you want to use gold / yellow fabric in your quilt, please use it in the lattice or the border areas.
