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

Heart Block

All seams are 1/4 inch unless otherwise noted.


On the WRONG side of the **Background** fabric 4-1/2 and 2-1/2 inch squares, draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other corner.

Or, with **WRONG** sides together, fold the square in half along the diagonal. Press a crease along the diagonal fold. The pressed diagonal crease will be your stitching line.



With Right Sides Together (RST) place a marked **Background** fabric 2-1/2 inch square on top of a **Heart** fabric 2-1/2 x 4-1/2 inch rectangle as shown below. Line up the cut edges of these pieces, then stitch along the drawn line / pressed crease.


Trim to 1/4 inch away from the stitched line. For easier quilting, press this seam OPEN!




Take another **Background** fabric 2-1/2 inch square and place it RST on the other corner of this piece. Stich along the drawn line / pressed crease, then trim and press as you did the other side.

This makes Flying Geese Unit that measures 2-1/2 inches $\times 4-1/2$ inches which includes seam allowance.

Use remaining the remaining 2-1/2 inch **Background** fabric pieces and the 2-1/2 x 4-1/2 inch Heart fabric piece to make 1 more Flying Geese Unit.






Completed Flying Geese Unit 2-1/2 inch x 4-1/2 inches **Make 2**

Take 2 of the **Heart** fabric 2-1/2 inch squares and stitch together. Press as desired.


Repeat for the other 2 **Heart** fabric pieces.



With Right Sides Together (RST) place a marked **Background** fabric 4-1/2 inch square on top of a **Heart** fabric 4-1/2 inch square as shown at the right. Line up the cut edges of these pieces, then stitch along the drawn line / pressed crease.


Trim to 1/4 inch away from the stitched line. For easier quilting, **press this seam OPEN!**


Repeat for the remaining 4-1/2 inch **Back-ground** and **Heart** fabric squares.



Take the heart pieces and lay them out exactly as shown below left. Stitch the block together and press as desired.


The completed block should measure $8-1/2 \times 8-1/2$ inches, which includes seam allowances.






Take the **Block Sashing** and **Inner Border** fabric pieces and stitch them to the Heart block. Press as desired.

The completed block should measure 12-1/2 x 12-1/2 inches, which includes seam allowances.



Take the **Background** / **Outer Border 9 inch x wof** strips and stitch them to the Heart block in your usual manner. Press as desired.

The completed Table Topper should measure $28-1/2 \times 28-1/2$ inches, which includes seam allowances and is ready for quilting!




Right Half of Heart quilting template

Trace Heart shape onto piecing template material and cut out.




Left Half of Heart quilting template
